



## Application overview

IDEA² applications include five components:

1. A project description
2. A short overview video
3. A reference letter
4. Registration for each team member
5. Participation fee

## Project application preview

Please, **DO NOT disclose any confidential information** in the application. With a few exceptions, the information provided will not be made public and will be shared only with those involved in program management and delivery. The exceptions are that, for those selected to participate, we will publish your name, project titles, and short project description.

*All information is required except when indicated as optional*

### **Project administrative**

- Project Title
- Short project title (maximum 20 alpha-numeric characters)
- How long have you (or your team) been working on this project?
- How many people are on your project team?  
*(Count only those who will be involved in doing the work of the program and/or those you would like included on any email communications from the program. Note that each person will need to submit a registration form; instructions will be provided after this application is submitted.)*
- Team Administrator Name

### Project description

*Only one project description is needed per team*

This project description should provide a “stand alone” statement that clearly articulates the problem you are solving (or the question you are asking). It should also indicate the approach you are taking.

We are interested in a broad range of biomedical projects. Past IDEA<sup>2</sup> projects have ranged from hypothesis-driven science seeking to better understand mechanisms underlying human disease, to the design and testing of novel technology to improve patient care.

- Innovation opportunity  
*Provide a brief overview of the unmet medical need you propose to solve. What is the burden of the problem? This should be understandable and compelling to someone not skilled in the art. ≤ 250 words*
- Potential impact  
*What is the potential societal impact of solving the problem? Who will benefit from the solution? This should be understandable and compelling to someone not skilled in the art.*
- Your proposed solution  
*Describe your project to solve the problem, and please indicate briefly what evidence of progress you have (such as research data, market data, publications, patents or patents in process, etc.)*
- Prior solutions  
*Have there been any previous approaches to solving this problem (or answering the question)? Please describe how your idea is original. ≤ 250 words*
- Summary  
*Please provide a short description of the unmet medical need and your proposed solution, suitable to use in public materials (website, press releases, etc.).*
- Tell us something interesting about yourself (and your team). ≤ 250 words
- Why do you want to participate in the program and what do you hope to gain from the program? ≤ 250 words

## IDEA<sup>2</sup> Project Application and Team Registration preview

- Optional: Add here any literature references that you wish to add to your application ≤ 500 words

### Pitch Video

*Only one pitch video per team.*

Please upload a short project overview video. The video should have three parts, each not more than one minute long:

1. The unmet need your project will address
2. Your proposed response to the need
3. An overview of your background / your team's backgrounds

The video should not exceed **three minutes**. Don't worry about elaborate production values; the video should just capture you / your team speaking with reasonable quality.

Pitch video title: Please follow the format *[Your Team Name]\_IDEA2* for your video title. *[Your Team Name]* should match the project title you use in the application form.

Video upload: You will upload your final video to a private Dropbox. Your video file will be available only to program organizers.

### Letter of reference, invitation letter/e-mail

You will upload at least one reference / support letter from any mentor, supervisor, faculty, or the invitation from your sponsoring organization.

## Team member registration preview

Before completing this form, be sure you have completed an IDEA<sup>2</sup> project application in which your team provides information about your project. This registration form captures contact and demographic information for each individual participating in the project. All team members will receive program-related emails. As needed, the person and email provided with the IDEA<sup>2</sup> project application will be considered the person responsible for ensuring timely responses to requests from the program.

- Any other information you wish the IDEA<sup>2</sup> Global team to know? ≤ 150 words

## Participation fee

Teams accepted into the IDEA<sup>2</sup> program are required to pay a participation fee of USD \$5,000, due two weeks before the kickoff workshop, to join the program.

We are committed to making IDEA<sup>2</sup> accessible to all qualified teams, regardless of financial circumstances. A limited number of need-based sponsorships are available to cover all or part of the program fee.
